Professor Edward K Y Chen, GBS, CBE, JP, former President of Lingnan University (1995 to 2007), is an internationally renowned scholar pioneering the studies in newly industrialized economies and published numerous books and articles in international refereed journals. Professor Chen received his education at The University of Hong Kong (B.A., M.Soc.Sc.) and Oxford University (D.Phil.). He is Honorary Professor of The Open University of Hong Kong and Distinguished Fellow of the Hong Kong Institute for the Humanities and Social Sciences at The University of Hong Kong. He is also Honorary Professor of several universities on the Mainland, including Shantou University and Jinan University. He has held visiting appointments at Yale, Oxford, Stockholm Universities, and the University of California (Davis Campus). Professor Chen is now Chairman of the Board of Directors of HKU SPACE and President of the Qianhai Institute for Innovative Research in Shenzhen.
